
CARTRIDGE REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS


TOOLS NEEDED:

- 2mm Allen wrench
- 12mm Socket wrench

1. TURN OFF THE WATER SUPPLY TO THE FAUCET USING THE SHUT-OFF VALVE UNDER THE KITCHEN SINK!

- 2. Turn the handle of the faucet to the "open" position.
- 3. On the underside of the handle, which is now on the back, there is a small hole. In that hole is a set screw which must be loosened with a 2mm Allen wrench. Loosen the set screw 1-2 turns. It's not necessary to remove it completely.
- 4. Pull the handle off of the faucet. It may be stuck and take some wiggling to get it loose.
- 5. Use a 12mm socket to unscrew the cartridge.
- 6. Screw in the new cartridge and use a 12mm socket to tighten. About 6-8 ft-lbs is recommended (that means get it nice and snug but don't muscle it).
- 7. Replace the handle and make sure to align it properly (vertical for closed, horizontal for open).
- 8. Tighten the set screw using the 2mm Allen wrench.







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
